- 3-D must be exhibit ready, and come with presentation instructions
- Each artist may submit two pieces
- Each piece must have two copies of the labels attached to the back

Screening of work:

Drop off is Saturday, February 25, between 11am and 5 pm, at Panza Gallery. Artists will be notified when they pick up their work that day. Accepted artists' works will remain at the gallery. All others may be picked up between 3:30 and 5pm on the 25th.

Fee: \$20. Checks can be delivered with the artwork and made payable to Associated Artists of Pittsburgh.
